Financial assistance from BABS Harmony Foundation is available to men and women and open to BABS members and non-members. Costs which may be met by a grant are Educational Fees, Course Fees, Residential Fees, Insurance and Project costs related to mounting an educational event. This list is not exhaustive and there may be requests for other costs to be met which might be accepted by the Charity's Trustees. Listed below is a brief synopsis of what each fund covers.

### **Keep Harmony Alive & Memorial Educational Funds**

*These Funds provide grants and scholarships to promote, encourage and enhance singing in the Barbershop style. Examples of Barbershop educational events for which grants and scholarships can be awarded are BABS Harmony College and Directors College, The American Barbershop Society's Harmony University and Directors College plus other local or regional educational events including events not necessarily organised by BABS.*

### **The Steve Hall Fund**

*Supports barbershop education of young people, the improvement of directing and coaching skills and the development of musical arrangement skills.*

### **The Don Amos Life President's Fund**

*Supports the improvement of singing competence, the improvement of quartet performance through education or coaching programmes and the development of experienced quartet singers to become effective coaches.*

### **The Martin Hill Fund**

*Supports the training of new club officers and particularly for officers of new clubs in club administration.*

### **How to Apply**

Contact the Administration Director at the address below, an application form and a 'Guideline and Advice' sheet will be sent for completion, to simplify the collection of information for consideration by the Trustees.

The Trustees meet 6 times per year and the completed applications should be submitted at least 8 weeks in advance of the Trustees meeting.

Dates of meetings will be provided with the application form.

The Trustees decision is final and will be notified to you in writing shortly after the Trustees meeting. No further correspondence will be entered into.
